Finished Quilt Approx. 49-1/2" x 49-1/2" - Finished Center Size: 22-1/2"

Country Fresh fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4097

Fabric Requirements:

Based on 42" wide fabric
3/4 yard scenic print #61306-9
5/8 yard tomato print (#61307-1)
5/8 yard cabbage print (#61308-6)
5/8 yard corn print (#61309-4)
3/8 yard carrots print (#61310-7)
1-1/3 yards brown tonal (#61311-93), includes binding
3-1/3 yards backing (see packet #61312-9 suggested)
56" x 56" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions:

All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **scenic print**:

Cut one 23" x 42" strip, recut into one 23" square

From each of the **tomato print** and **cabbage prints**:

Cut one 8-3/8" x 42" strip, recut into two 8-3/8" squares*

Cut one 8" x 42" strip, recut into two 8" x 15-1/2" strips

From the **corn print**:

Cut one 8-3/8" x 42" strip, recut into two 8-3/8" squares*

Cut one 8" x 42" strip, recut into four 8" squares

From the **carrot print**:

Cut one 8-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into four 8-1/2" squares


From the **brown tonal**:

Cut one 8-7/8" x 42" strip, recut into four 8-7/8" squares*

Cut five 2-3/4" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end then cut into four equal length borders

Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips

Cut squares as indicated:





Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch two 8-7/8" to adjoining sides of each of the 8-1/2" carrot print squares as shown. Make 4.



2. Sew the carrot units to all sides of the 23" scenic print squares for quilt center.

3. Arrange 8-3/8" triangles, 8" squares and 8" x 15-1/2" strips as shown. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make two of each corner units.

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4. Sew the corner units to the quilt center as shown.



5. Sew 2-3/4" brown tonal borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess. Add remaining 2-3/4" brown tonal borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess.

Finishing:

1. Sew the two lengths of backing together along selvage edges creating a two-panel wide backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 42" dark tonal strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
