

DinoMyte - Square-in-a-Square Quilt

Quilt Designed by Lucy A. Fazely

Finished Quilt Approx. 64" x 84" - Finished Block Size: 10" square

Dino-Myte fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4095

Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric

3/4 yard navy dino print (#61298-2)
1-5/8 yards blue dino print (#61298-5)
1-1/8 yards navy leaf print (#61299-2)
1-1/8 yards colored boxes print (#61300-100)
7/8 yard blue print (#61301-2)
1 yard green print (#61301-6)
2/3 yard orange print (#61301-7)
5-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#61299-6 suggested)
72" x 92" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **navy dino** print:

Fussy cut eighteen 5-1/2" squares with motifs centered as much as possible

From the **blue dino** print:

Cut five 10-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into seventeen 10-1/2" squares

From the **navy leaf** print:

Cut (17) 2" x 42" strips, recut into (36) 2" x 10-1/2" and (36) 2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the **colored boxes** print:

Cut seven 4-1/2" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and then cut into two 4-1/2" x 72-1/2" and two 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders

From the **blue** print:

Cut seven 2-1/2" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and then cut into two 2-1/2" x 80-1/2" and two 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders

Cut five 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and twelve 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips

From the **green** print:

Cut eight 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

Cut five 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and twelve 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips

From the **orange** print:

Cut six 1-1/2" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and then cut into two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" and two 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders

Cut five 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and twelve 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips

Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips blue print strips to opposite sides of a 5-1/2" navy dino square. Add 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" blue print strips to top and bottom. Sew 2" x 7-1/2" navy leaf strips to right and left sides of block then add 2" x 10-1/2" navy leaf strips to top and bottom of block. Make a total of six blue blocks (10-1/2" square unfinished).

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2. Referring to Step 1, make six each green and orange blocks using green or orange 1-1/2" strips around the block centers.

3. Referring to color quilt layout, arrange blocks and 10-1/2" blue dino squares in 7 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together. Quilt center measures 50-1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished).

4. Stitch 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" orange print borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" orange print borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

5. Stitch 4-1/2" x 72-1/2" colored boxes print borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" colored boxes print borders to top and bottom of quilt.

6. Stitch 2-1/2" x 80-1/2" blue print borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" blue print borders to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

1. Sew the two lengths of backing together along selvage edges creating a two-panel wide backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

2. Prepare binding from eight 2-1/2" x 42" green strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.

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
