## Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric

- 1-1/3 yards black floral (#60926-8)
- 3/4 yard blue floral (#61125-2)
- 1/2 yard yellow floral (#61125-4)
- 2/3 yard navy floral (#61125-25)
- 1/2 yard wavy lines (#61126-1)
- 3/4 yard navy mini floral (#61127-2)
- 1/4 yard red mini floral (#61127-1)
- 1/4 yard red paisley (#61128-1)
- 1/2 yard blue paisley (#61128-2)
- 3-1/3 yards fabric for backing (#61126-2 suggested)
- 58" x 67" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

## Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

### From the **black floral**:

- Cut six 4" x 42" strips for border
- Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

### From the **blue floral**:

- Cut ten 2" x 42" strips

### From the **yellow floral**:

- Cut four 2" x 42" strips

### From the **navy floral**:

- Cut eight 2" x 42" strips

### From the **wavy lines**:

- Cut four 2" x 42" strips

### From the **navy mini floral**:

- Cut five 2" x 42" strips
- Cut five 1-1/2" x 42" strips for border

### From the **red mini floral**:

- Cut two 2" x 42" strips

### From the **red paisley**:


- Cut two 2" x 42" strips

### From the **blue paisley**:

- Cut four 2" x 42" strips


## Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch a 2" mini navy floral strip between two 2" blue floral strips. Make a total of five strip set panels. From these, cut a total of twenty 5" x 9-1/2" blocks.




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
2. Stitch a 2" blue paisley strip between two 2" navy floral strips. Make a total of four strip set panels. From these, cut a total of twelve 5" x 9-1/2" blocks and eight 2-3/4" x 5" blocks.



3. Stitch a 2" red paisley strip between two 2" yellow floral strips. Make a total of two strip set panels. From these, cut a total of sixteen 5" x 5" blocks.



4. Stitch a 2" red mini floral strip between two 2" wavy stripe strips. Make a total of two strip set panels. From these, cut a total of fifteen 5" x 5" blocks.



### Assembly:

1. Referring to Quilt Layout, arrange all blocks in nine vertical rows. Stitch blocks into vertical rows. Sew rows together to create 41" x 50" quilt center.

2. Sew five 1-1/2" navy mini floral strips together end to end. Cut into four equal length borders. Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess. Add remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim excess.

3. Sew six 4" black floral strips together end to end. Cut into four equal length borders. Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess.

### Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths of backing together along selvage edges creating a two-panel wide backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 42" black floral strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
