

Paloma Wall Quilt

Quilt designed by Lucy A. Fazely

Finished Quilt Approximately: 50" x 50" - Block Size: 14" square

Paloma fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4080

Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric
one **Paloma** panel (#61222-90)
1/2 yard black bird print (#61223-8)
1/2 yard cream bird print (#61223-9)
2/3 yard black floral (#61224-8)
5/8 yard tan floral (#61224-9)
2/3 yard gray/black birds (#61225-8)
1/2 yard cream/tan birds (#61225-90)
3/4 yard gray/black flowers (#61226-8)
1/3 yard cream/tan flowers (#61226-90)
3-1/3 yards fabric for backing (#61223-8 suggested)
58" x 58" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.


Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **black bird print** fabric:

Cut one 11-1/4" x 42" strip, subcut one 11-1/4" square** and four 4-7/8" squares***

From the **cream bird print** fabric:

Cut three 3-3/8" x 42" strips, recut four strips using the Strip Template and four using the **reverse** of the Strip Template



From the **black floral** fabric:

Cut five 3-1/2" x 42" strips for border

From the **tan floral** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 42" strip, recut one 3-1/4" square** and eight 2-1/2" squares

Cut one 2-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into sixteen 2-1/2" squares

Cut five 1-1/2" x 42" strips for border

From the **gray/black bird** fabric:

Cut one 3-3/8" x 42" strip, recut four 3-3/8" squares and four 3-1/4" squares**

Cut nine 1-1/2" strips, subcut ten 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" and ten 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

From the **cream/tan bird** fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twenty-eight 2-1/2" squares

Cut four 1-1/4" strips, subcut ten 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips

From the **gray/black flower** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 42" strip, recut four 3-1/4" squares** and six 2-7/8" squares*

Cut one 2-7/8" x 42" strip, recut into fourteen 2-7/8" squares*


Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

From the **cream/tan flower** fabric:

Cut one 3-1/4" x 42" strip, recut two 3-1/4" squares** and two 2-7/8" squares*

Cut one 2-7/8" x 42" strip, recut into fourteen 2-7/8" squares*

Cut squares as indicated:



***cut half in one direction, half in other direction

Quilt Center:


1. Trim five panels to 11" x 12-1/2", with design centered in each.
2. Stitch 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" cream/tan bird strips to right and left sides of each panel.
3. Stitch 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" gray/black bird strips to right and left sides of each panel. Add 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" gray/black bird strips to top and bottom of panels for a total of five blocks.






4. Arrange three 2-1/2" cream/tan bird squares, four 2-7/8" gray/black flower triangles and two 3-1/4" gray/black flower triangles in four rows as shown. Stitch squares and triangles into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of four Unit 1.




5. Arrange four 2-1/2" cream/tan bird squares, six 2-7/8" gray/black flower triangles and two 3-1/4" gray/black flower triangles five rows as shown. Stitch squares and triangles into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of four Unit 2.




6. Make four of each Triangle Units A, B and C as shown using 3-1/4" triangles.




7. Arrange three 2-1/2" tan floral squares, four 2-7/8" cream/tan flower triangles, one 3-1/4" gray/black flower triangle and one Triangle Unit A in four rows as shown. Stitch squares and triangles into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of four Unit 3.




8. Arrange three 2-1/2" tan floral squares, four 2-7/8" cream/tan flower triangles and one each Triangle Unit A and B in four rows as shown. Stitch squares and triangles into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of four Unit 4.




9. Stitch a Unit 1 to short side of a 11-1/4" black bird print triangle as shown. Add a Unit 2 to other short side of triangle.



10. Stitch a cream bird print strip cut with **reverse** Strip Template to Unit 1 side of block. Sew a 3-3/8" gray/black bird square to square end of a cream bird print strip cut with Strip Template then add to the left side of block.



11. Stitch a Unit 3 to left side of the block as shown. Add a Unit 4 to right side of block.



12. Sew 4-7/8" black bird print triangles to top corners of the block. Make a total of four 14-1/2" blocks, unfinished.



13. Referring to color quilt image, arrange blocks in three rows. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center.

14. Sew five 1-1/2" x 42" tan floral strips together end to end. Cut into four equal length borders. Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess. Add remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Press and trim excess.

15. Add a 3-1/2" black floral border in the same manner as the first border.

Strip Template

Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths together along selvage edges. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 42" gray/black flower strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
