Fade to Black fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4098

Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric

3/8 yard white large floral (#61313-100)
3/8 yard black large floral (#61313-8)
3/8 yard white scroll (#61314-100)
3/8 yard black scroll (#61314-8)
3/8 yard white small floral (#61315-100)
3/8 yard black small floral (#61315-8)
3/8 yard white electronic circuits (#61317-100)
1-1/4 yards black electronic circuits (#61317-8)
3/8 yard white broken stripes (#61318-100)
3/8 yard black broken stripes (#61318-8)
3/8 yard white leaves (#61319-100)
3/8 yard black leaves (#61319-8)
7/8 yard white solid (#400-100 White)
1/3 yard red solid (#400-159 Scarlet)
3/8 yard yellow solid (#400-440 Calico Yellow)
2-2/3 yards black solid (#400-888 Black)
4-1/2 yards backing (#61320-100 suggested)
78" x 78" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Prints cut for block construction are cut from 2" or 3-1/2" strips so the directional prints will be properly orientated in the blocks.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From each of the **white large floral**, **black large floral** and **white electronic circuits** prints: *(2 roof, 1 door, 1 window)*

Cut two 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into two 3-1/2" x 10-1/4 strips, two 3-1/2" x 5" pieces and five 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut one 2" x 42" strip, recut into two 2" x 8" strips and three 2" x 5" strip

From the **black electronic circuits** print: *(2 roof, 1 door, 1 window)*

Cut seven 4" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into 4" x 69" and 4" x 62" borders

Cut two 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into two 3-1/2" x 10-1/4 strips, two 3-1/2" x 5" pieces and five 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut one 2" x 42" strip, recut into two 2" x 8" strips and three 2" x 5" strip

From each of the **white large scroll**, **white black scroll**, **white broken stripes** and

black broken stripes prints: *(1 roof, 2 door, 1 window)*

Cut two 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into one 3-1/2" x 10-1/4 strip, four 3-1/2" x 5" pieces and seven 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut one 2" x 42" strip, recut into two 2" x 8" strips and two 2" x 5" strips

From each of the **white small floral**, **black small floral**, **white leaves** and **black leaves** prints: *(1 roof, 1 door, 2 window)*

Cut two 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into one 3-1/2" x 10-1/4 strip, two 3-1/2" x 5" pieces and eight 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Cut one 2" x 42" strip, recut into four 2" x 8" strips and one 2" x 5" strip

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From the **white solid**:

Cut five 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into eight 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips, thirty-two 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" and eight 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" pieces

Cut four 2" x 42" strips, subcut into sixteen 2" x 8" strips

From the **red solid**:

Cut three 2" x 42" strip, recut thirty-two 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

From the **yellow solid**:

Cut four 2" x 42" strip, recut forty-eight 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

From the **black solid**:

Cut five 3-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into eight 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips, thirty-two 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" and eight 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" pieces

Cut eight 2-1/2" strips, binding

Cut four 2" x 42" strips, subcut into sixteen 2" x 8" strips

Cut eleven 2" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into two 2" x 62" and five 2" x 59" borders

Cut four 2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 2" x 14" sashing strips

Cut seven 1-1/2" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into two 1-1/2" x 71" and two 1-1/2" x 69" borders

Separating Fabric Pieces:

1. In red, on under the cutting directions, is listed the number of blocks that print is used in. For instance: From the **white large floral** print (*2 roof, 1 door, 1 window*) you will have enough fabric pieces for 2 roof, 1 door and 1 window section.

Separate the pieces of each print into piles with the cuts listed for each section:

For each roof section: one 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" strip

For each door section: two 3-1/2" x 5" piece, two 2" x 3-1/2" and one 2" x 5" pieces

For each window section: two 2" x 8" strips and three 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

Black Background Blocks:

1. Select a white leaf 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" strip for roof, a pile of white small floral pieces for door section and a pile of white scroll pieces for a window section. You will also need two red solid and three yellow solid 2" x 3-1/2" pieces. The background requires the following black solid pieces: four 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" pieces, one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, one 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece and four 2" x 8" strips.

2. Stitch a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip black solid strip between two red solid 2" x 3-1/2" pieces. Add black solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" pieces to the red pieces to complete the sky unit (3-1/2" x 14" unfinished).



3. Use templates to trim excess from the following pieces as listed:



Trim one black solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" piece with **Left Sky Template**.

Trim one black solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" piece with **Right Sky Template**.

Trim one black solid 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece with **Roof Line Template**.

Trim one 'door' 3-1/2" x 5" piece (white small floral for this first block) with the **Gable Template**.

Trim 'roof' 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" strip (white leaf for this first block) with the **Roof Template**.



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
4. Stitch the left sky piece and skyline piece to the gable piece as shown. Add the roof piece then the right sky piece to complete the roof unit

(3-1/2" x 14" unfinished).

5. Sew a yellow solid 2" x 3-1/2" piece between two 2" x 3-1/2" 'door' pieces (white small floral for this block). Add 2" x 5" and 3-1/2" x 5" 'door' (white small floral for this block) pieces to top and bottom of unit. Add 2" x 8" black solid strip to right side to complete door unit (6-1/2" x 8" unfinished).



Door Unit


6. Arrange two solid yellow and three 'window' (white scroll for this block) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces in a row as shown.

Stitch into a row. Add 2" x 8" 'window' strips to top and bottom of unit, then add a 2" x 8" black solid strip to the top to complete the window unit (8" square unfinished).

7. Stitch door and window units together as shown. Sew sky and roof units together. Stitch the two halves of the block together.

8. In the same manner, make a total eight black background blocks referring to the color quilt image for fabric placement. Unfinished blocks 14" square.

White Background Blocks:

1. Select a black electronic circuit 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" strip for roof, a pile of black broken stripe pieces for door section and a pile of black leaf pieces for a window section. You will also need two red solid and three yellow solid 2" x 3-1/2" pieces. The background requires the following white solid pieces: four 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" pieces, one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, one 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece and four 2" x 8" strips.

2. Stitch a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip white solid strip between two red solid 2" x 3-1/2" pieces. Add white solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" pieces to the red pieces to complete the sky unit (3-1/2" x 14" unfinished).

3. Use template to trim excess from the following pieces as listed:

Trim one white solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" piece with **Left Sky Template**.


Trim one white solid 2-3/4" x 3-1/2" piece with **Right Sky Template**.

Trim one white solid 3-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece with **Roof Line Template**.

Trim one 'door' 3-1/2" x 5" piece (black broken stripes for this first block) with the **Gable Template**.

Trim 'roof' 3-1/2" x 10-1/4" strip (electronic circuit for this first block) with the **Roof Template**.

4. Stitch the left sky piece and skyline piece to the gable piece as shown. Add the roof piece then the right sky piece to complete the roof unit




Roof Unit

(3-1/2" x 14" unfinished).


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5. Sew a yellow solid 2" x 3-1/2" piece between two 2" x 3-1/2" 'door' pieces (black broken stripe for this block). Add 2" x 5" and 3-1/2" x 5" 'door' (black broken stripe for this block) pieces to top and bottom of unit. Add 2" x 8" white solid strip to right side to complete door unit (6-1/2" x 8" unfinished).




Door Unit

6. Arrange two solid yellow and three 'window' (black leaf for this block) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces in a row as shown. Stitch into a row. Add 2" x 8" 'window' strips to top and bottom of unit, then add a 2" x 8" white solid strip to the top to complete the window unit (8" square unfinished).

7. Stitch door and window units together as shown. Sew sky and roof units together. Stitch the two halves of the block together.

8. In the same manner, make a total eight white background blocks referring to the color quilt image for fabric placement. Unfinished blocks 14" square.

Assembly:

1. Arrange blocks and black solid 2" x 14" sashing strips in four rows. Sew into rows. Stitch 2" x 59" borders (used as long sashing strips) between the rows of blocks to complete the quilt center (59" square unfinished).

2. Stitch black solid 2" x 59" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add black solid 2" x 62" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

3. Stitch black electronic circuit 4" x 62" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add black electronic circuit 4" x 69" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

4. Stitch black solid 1-1/2" x 69" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add black solid 1-1/2" x 71" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

1. Sew the two lengths of backing together along selvage edges creating a two-panel wide backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.




2. Prepare binding from eight 2-1/2" x 42" black solid strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.


