Fall Reflections Quilt

for Exclusively Quilters by Nancy Vasilchik
57" X 73"

SUPPLIES

1 panel
brown blender - 1½ yard
green blender - ¾ yard
yellow gold blender - ¾ yard
orange blender - ½ yard
leaf print - 1¾ yard
backing - 3½ yards

CUTTING

trim panel as close to 24½" X 40½" as possible. Keep the black edges all the same size.

See border cutting pages to cut blocks for 1st border.

Cut 6 - 2½" X width of fabric strips from orange blender

Cut 8 - 6¾" X width of fabric strips from leaf print

Cut 8 - 2½" width of fabric from brown blender

CONSTRUCTION

all seams ¼"

Assemble all blocks from the border block page. Seam two side borders of 5 blocks each. The green triangles will always attach to the panel. The brown triangles will face the outside of the quilt. The four blocks that only have one green triangle will be placed in the corners, on the sides of the top and bottom border. Seam borders to sides.

Assemble the top and bottom border of 5 blocks each. Seam borders to the top and bottom.

Join orange blender strips with a 45° angle to make the second border. Seam to quilt.

Tips

- All borders are put first on the sides of the quilt and then on the top and bottom.
- To determine the length of borders, measure the center of the quilt and cut the border the same size as the center. Side border length is determined by measuring from the top to the bottom in the center. Top and bottom borders are determined by measuring from one side to the other in the center. This technique will eliminate wavy borders and help keep the quilt squared up.

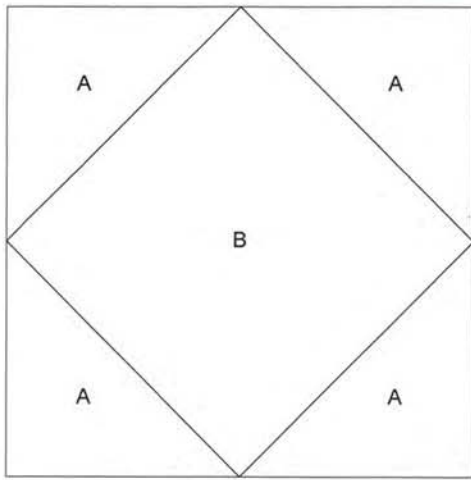
Join leaf print strips with a 45° angle to make the outer borders. Seam side borders to quilt, then seam top and bottom borders to quilt.

Backing and batting should be at least 2" bigger than quilt top on all sides. Sandwich backing, right side down, batting, then quilt top right side up. Baste layers together. Quilt layers together. The panel is fun to quilt around the images to make the picture stand out. Trim backing and batting to the size of the quilt top.

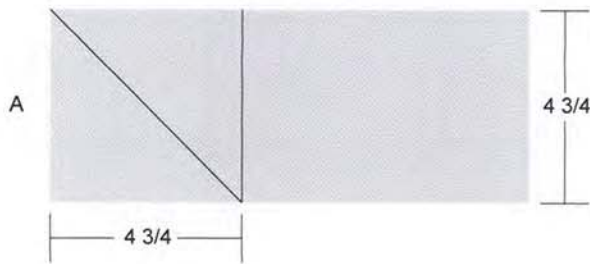
Join binding strips with a 45° angle. Bind the quilt.

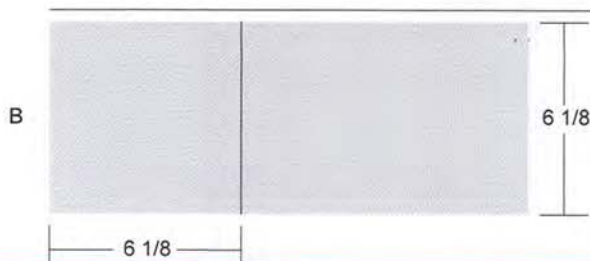

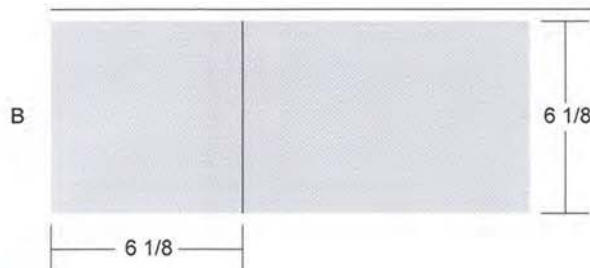
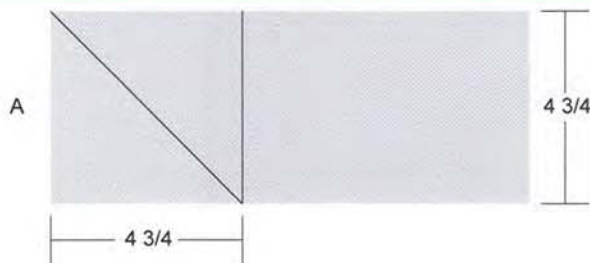
Cutting Diagrams
