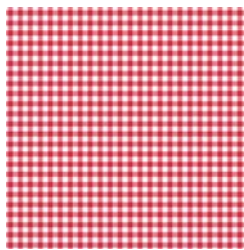

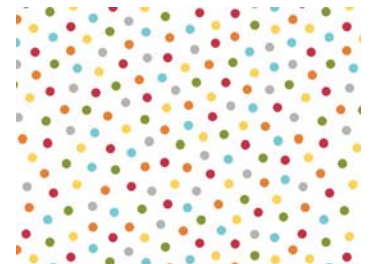

Fabric 6	blocks	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	4092-61282-6
Fabric 7	blocks	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	4092-61280-6
Backing		3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	4092-61283-100

General Directions

Pattern is based of 40" usable fabric (selvedge to selvedge).

Unless otherwise noted, use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Press seams open (this is just how I prefer to do it).

Please read complete pattern before cutting fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric



Fabric Cutting

Fabric 1

Fussy Cut 1 - 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Center**

Fabric 2

Cut 17 - 2" x WOF (piece lengthwise as needed)

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 1, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

Border 1, Top & Bottom

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 3, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

Border 3, Top & Bottom

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 5, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

Border 5, Top & Bottom

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 7, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 2" x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

Border 7, Top & Bottom

Cut 7 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, **Binding**

Fabric 3

Cut 5 - 2" x WOF

Sub-cut into 20 - 2" x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece B**

Sub-cut into 20 - 2" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece C**

Cut 1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub-cut into 10 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece D**

Fabric 4

Cut 1 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub-cut into 10 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece A**

Cut 5 - 2" x WOF

Sub-cut into 20 - 2" x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece E**

Sub-cut into 20 - 2" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece F**

Fabric 5

Cut 4 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Sub-cut into 2 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 4, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

Border 4, Top & Bottom

Cut 6 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (piece lengthwise as needed)

Sub-cut into 2 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 8, Sides**

Sub-cut into 2 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ ",

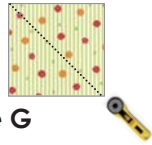
Border 8, Top & Bottom

Fabric Cutting Continued

Fabric 6

Cut 3 - 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

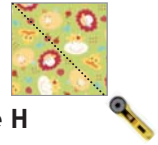
Sub-cut into 18 - 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ ",
cut in half diagonally, **Piece G**

Cut 3 - 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF

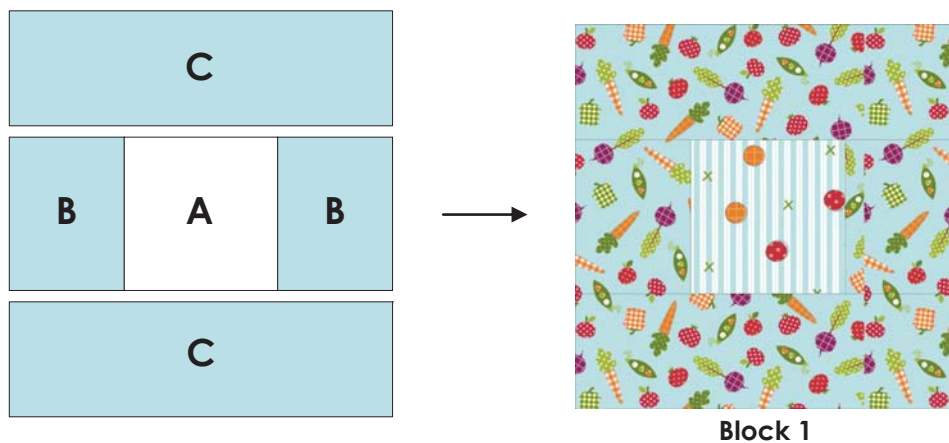
Sub-cut into 18 - 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ ",
cut in half diagonally, **Piece H**



Construction

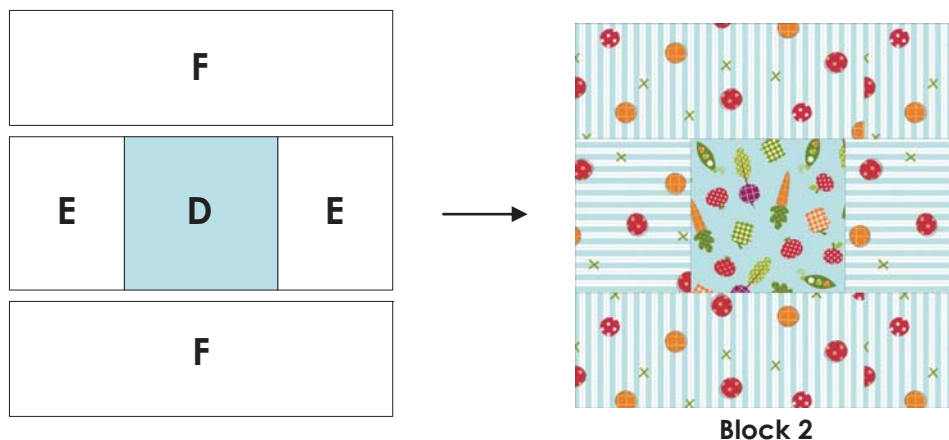
- Combine 1 of **Piece A**, 2 of **Piece B** and 2 of **Piece C** to make **Block 1** as shown below.
Repeat to make 10 of **Block 1**.

Block 1 should measure 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- Combine 1 of **Piece D**, 2 of **Piece E** and 2 of **Piece F** to make **Block 2** as shown below.
Repeat to make 10 of **Block 2**.

Block 2 should measure 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

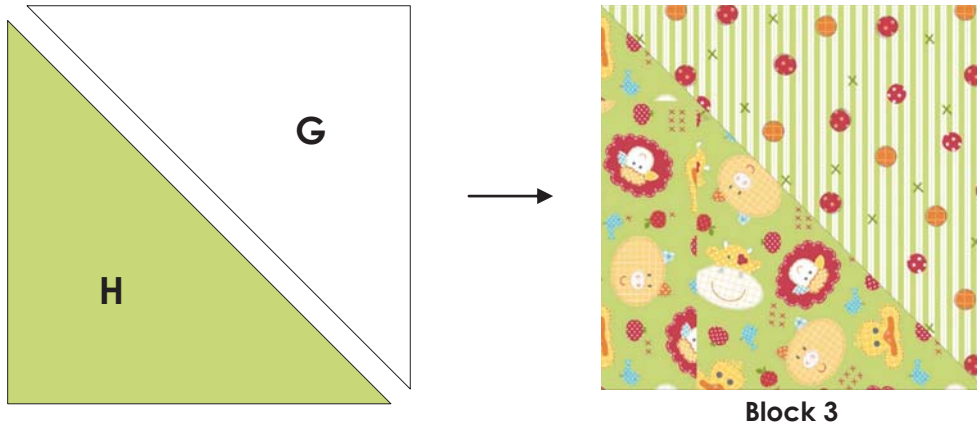

3. Combine 1 of **Piece G** and 1 of **Piece H** to make **Block 3** as shown below.

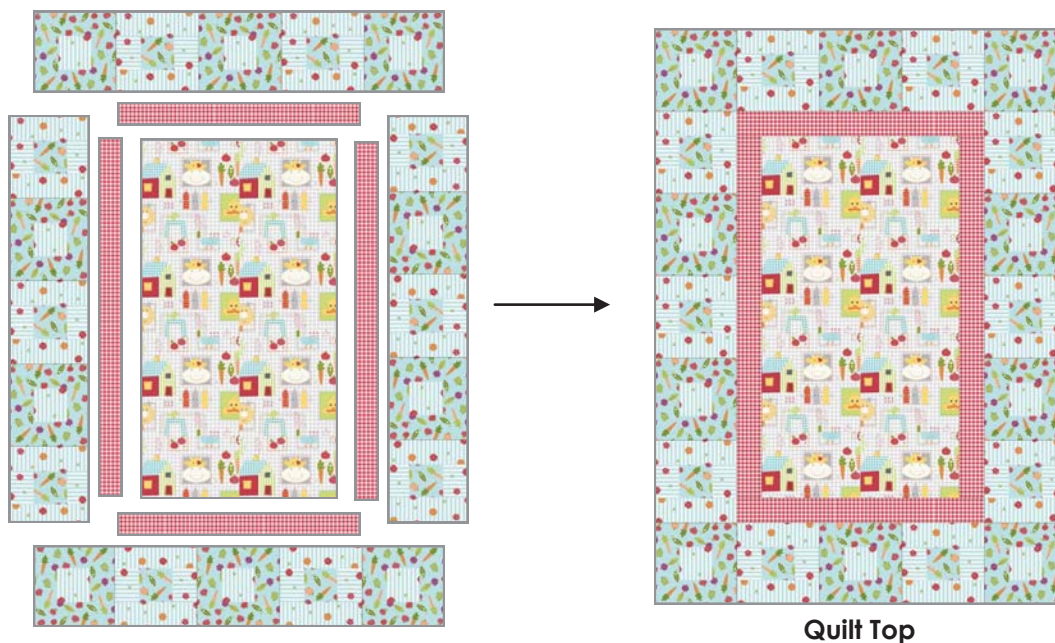
Repeat to make 36 of **Block 3**.

Block 3 should measure 5 ½" x 5 ½".



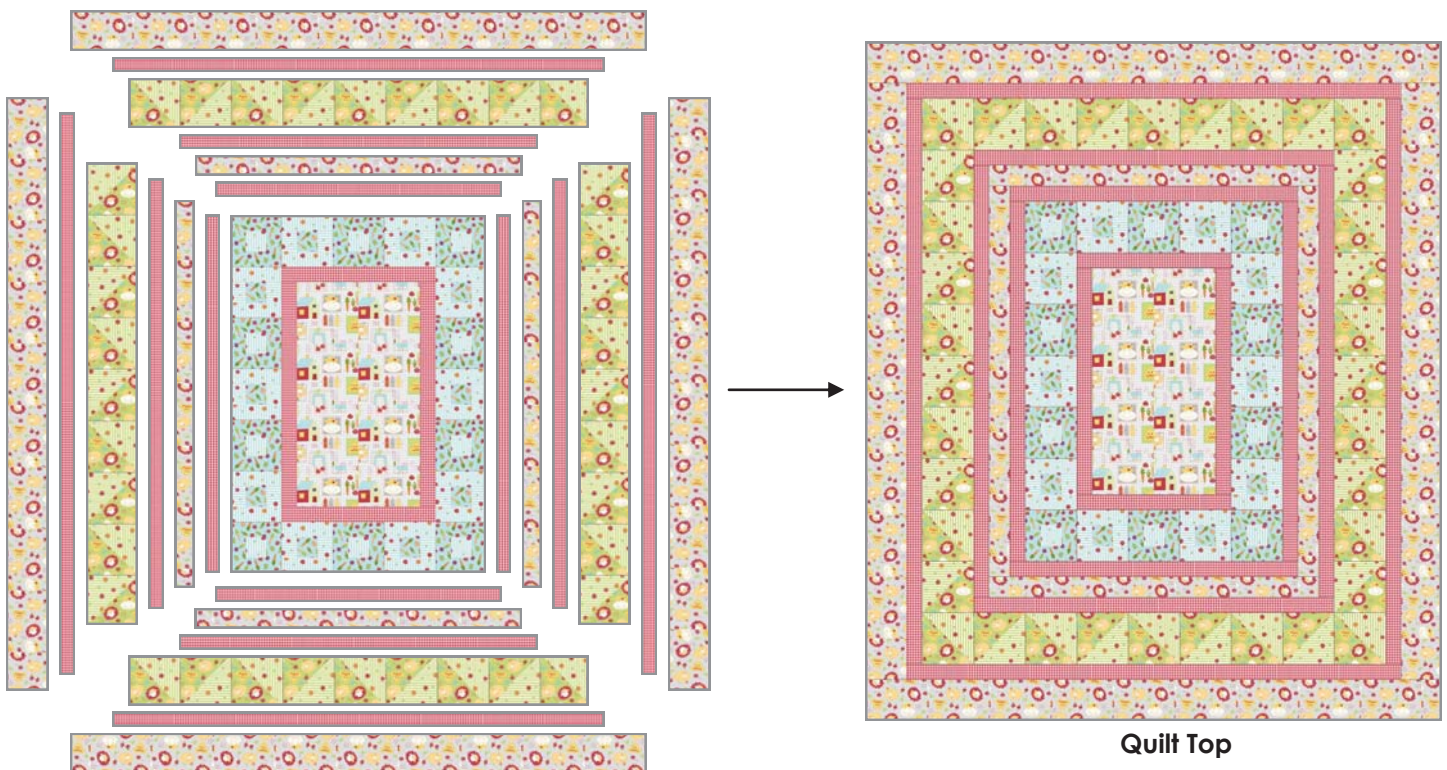
Quilt Assembly

4. Begin with **Center** add **Border 1, Sides**, then **Border 1, Top & Bottom**.
5. Combine 2 of **Block 1** and 3 of **Block 2** as per diagram below and add to the left side of the quilt.
6. Combine 2 of **Block 1** and 3 of **Block 2** as per diagram below and add to the right side of the quilt.
7. Combine 3 of **Block 1** and 2 of **Block 2** as per diagram below and add to the top of the quilt.
8. Combine 3 of **Block 1** and 2 of **Block 2** as per diagram below and add to the bottom of the quilt.
At this point the **Quilt Top** should measure 25 ½" x 35 ½".



Quilt Assembly Continued

9. Add **Border 3, Sides**, then **Border 3, Top & Bottom**.
10. Add **Border 4, Sides**, then **Border 4, Top & Bottom**.
11. Add **Border 5, Sides**, then **Border 5, Top & Bottom**.
12. Combine 9 of **Block 3** as per diagram below and add to the left side of the quilt.
13. Combine 9 of **Block 3** as per diagram below and add to the right side of the quilt.
14. Combine 9 of **Block 3** as per diagram below and add to the top of the quilt.
15. Combine 9 of **Block 3** as per diagram below and add to the bottom of the quilt.
At this point the **Quilt Top** should measure 45 ½" x 55 ½".
16. Add **Border 7, Sides**, then **Border 7, Top & Bottom**.
17. Add **Border 8, Sides**, then **Border 8, Top & Bottom**.
At this point the **Quilt Top** should measure 56 ½" x 66 ½".



Finishing

18. Cut backing fabric into 2 pieces and combine as shown.

19. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Baste and quilt.



20. Sew the **Binding** strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

21. Make sure you add a label to your quilt.
