

Holy Night

Quilt Designed by Lucy A. Fazely

Finished Quilt Approx. 39" x 59" - Finished Star Block: 5" x 5"

Nativity fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4091

Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric

One **Nativity** panel (#61273-2)

1/2 yard white tossed motif (#61274-90)

1-1/8 yards blue star (#61275-2)

1/4 yard white star (#61275-90)

1-1/2 yards angel print (#61276-2)

2-3/4 yards fabric for backing (#61274-2 suggested)

47" x 67" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **Nativity** panel:

Trim large panel to 21-1/2" wide x 25-1/2" tall and both small panels to 10-1/2" wide x 15-1/2" tall

From the **white tossed motif** print:

Cut four 3" x 42" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into two 3" x 44-1/2" and two 3" x 29-1/2" borders

From the **blue star** print:

Cut two 3" x 42" strips, subcut thirty-two 2-3/8" x 3" pieces

Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips (binding)

Cut four 2" x 42" strips, subcut two 2" x 41-1/2" and two 2" x 24-1/2" borders

Cut one 1-1/2" x 42" strip, subcut one 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" and one 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips

From the **white star** print:

Cut one 3" x 42" strip, subcut thirty-two 1-1/8" x 3" pieces

From the **angel** print:


Cut one 47-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into two 5-1/2" x 49-1/2" borders cut the length of fabric (parallel to the selvage); from the remaining width cut two 5-1/2" x 29-1/2" borders

Sewing Directions:


1. Refer to the color quilt image for placement and arrangement of panels, strips, blocks and borders.
2. Sew 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" blue star strip below large panel. Stitch 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" blue star strip between the two small panels. Sew small panels below large panel.
3. Stitch 2" x 41-1/2" blue star borders to right and left side of quilt. Add 2" x 24-1/2" blue star borders to top and bottom of quilt.
4. Stitch 3" x 44-1/2" white tossed motif borders to right and left side of quilt. Add 3" x 29-1/2" white tossed motif borders to top and bottom of quilt.

5. Trim sixteen white star 1-1/8" x 3" pieces with Template 1a and sixteen with Template 2a.



6. Trim sixteen blue star 2-3/8" x 3" pieces with Template 1b and sixteen with Template 2b.




7. Stitch a 1a piece to a 1b piece. Make 16. Stitch a 2a piece to a 2b piece. Make 16.




8. Sew one of each unit together as shown. Make a total of 16 quarter-block units.



9. Arrange four quarter-block units in two rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 star blocks.



10. Sew 5-1/2" x 49-1/2" angel borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch star blocks to both ends of each 5-1/2" x 29-1/2" angel borders then add to top and bottom of quilt.



Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew together along selvage edges to make backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 42" blue star strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
