

Starry Night

Quilt Designed by Lucy A. Fazely

Finished Quilt Approx. 37" x 48" - Finished Star Block: 4" x 4"

Nativity fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4091

Fabric Requirements:

Based on 42" wide fabric
One **Nativity** panel (#61273-2)
1 yard blue tossed motif print (#61274-2)
3/8 yard white tossed motif print (#61274-90)
1-1/8 yards blue star print (#61275-2)
1/4 yard white star print (#61275-90)
1/4 yard angel print (#61276-2)
1-3/4 yard fabric for backing (#61276-2 suggested)
42" x 54" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Cutting Directions:

All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.
From the **Nativity** panel:

Trim large panel to 18-1/2" wide x 23-1/2" tall and both small panels to 8-1/2" wide x 12-1/2" tall

From the **blue tossed motif** print:

Cut one 28-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into two 5" x 28-1/2" borders cut the length of fabric (parallel to the selvage); from the remaining width cut four 5" x 30" strips sewn together end to end matching design as much as possible and cut into two 5" x 39-1/2" borders

From the **white tossed motif** print:

Cut four 2" strips, subcut two 2" x 39-1/2" and two 2" x 25-1/2" borders

From the **blue star** print:

Cut one 4-1/2" x 42" strip, subcut two 3-1/2" x 4-1/2", two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and two 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

Cut five 2-1/2" x 42" strips (binding)

Cut four 2-1/2" x 42" strips, subcut eighty 2" x 2-1/2" pieces

Cut three 1-1/2" x 42" strips, subcut two 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" and two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" borders

From the **white star** print:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips, subcut eighty 1" x 2-1/2" pieces

From the **angel** print:


Fussy cut four 5" squares with angels centered

Sewing Directions:


1. Refer to the color quilt image for placement and arrangement of panels, strips, blocks and borders.

2. Sew 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" blue star borders to right and left sides of large panel. Add 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" blue star borders to top and bottom of large panel.

3. Trim forty white star 1" x 2-1/2" pieces with Template 1a and forty with Template 2a.



4. Trim forty blue stars 2" x 2-1/2" pieces with Template 1b and forty with Template 2b.


5. Stitch a 1a piece to a 1b piece. Make 40. Stitch a 2a piece to a 2b piece. Make 40.




6. Sew one of each unit together as shown. Make a total of 40 quarter-block units.



7. Arrange four quarter-block units in two rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 blocks.



8. Arrange five blocks and one each $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$, $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ and $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ blue star pieces in two vertical rows as shown. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together. Repeat to make a second star section with the rows reversed.



9. Sew small panels to the bottom of the star sections.

10. Sew star/small panel sections to the sides of the bordered large panel.

11. Stitch $2'' \times 25\frac{1}{2}''$ white tossed motif borders to right and left of quilt center. Add $2'' \times 39\frac{1}{2}''$ white tossed motif borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

12. Sew $5'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ blue tossed motifs to right and left sides of quilt. Sew $5''$ angel squares to both ends of $5'' \times 39\frac{1}{2}''$ blue tossed motifs. Add to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
2. Prepare binding from five $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 42''$ blue star strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}''$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
