

# Hanky Panky

Quilt by Lucy A. Fazely

Finished Quilt Approximately: 48" x 55" - Finished Block Size: 7" x 7"

**Hanky Panky** fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4016

**Fabric Requirements:** Based on 42" wide fabric

One set of **Hanky Panky** panels (#60915-90)  
1 yard tossed animals (#60916-90)  
1/4 yard dog house print (#60917-6)  
3/8 yard blue bubble floral (#60918-2)  
1/4 yard yellow bubble floral (#60918-4)  
1/4 yard green bubble floral (#60918-6)  
1/6 yard red bubble floral (#60918-7)  
3/4 yard yellow dot (#60919-4)  
1/4 yard green dot (#60919-6)  
1/8 yard red dot (#60919-7)  
3/8 yard pastel puppies (#60920-100)  
1/3 yard blue puppies (#60920-2)  
3-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#60916-2 suggested)  
56" x 63" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

**Cutting Directions:** All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the *panel* fabric:

Cut fifteen 7-1/2" panels

From the *tossed animals* fabric:

Cut five 5-1/2" x 42" strips

From the *dog house* fabric:

Cut one 5-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into four 5-1/2" squares

From the *blue bubble floral* fabric:

Cut four 2" x 42" strips

From the *yellow bubble floral* fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into six 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *green bubble floral* fabric:

Cut three 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *red bubble floral* fabric:

Cut two 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into six 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *yellow dot* fabric:

Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

Cut three 1-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *green dot* fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into six 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *red dot* fabric:

Cut one 2-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into three 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *pastel puppies* fabric:

Cut four 2" x 42" strips, recut into eighteen 2" x 7-1/2" strips

From the *blue puppies* fabric:

Cut three 2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 2" x 7-1/2" strips

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
## Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" red dot strip between two 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" red bubble floral strips lengthwise. Add 2" x 7-1/2" pastel puppies strips to the red bubble floral strips.



Make a total of three red blocks.

2. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" yellow bubble floral strip between two 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" yellow dot strips lengthwise. Add 2" x 7-1/2" pastel puppies strips to the yellow dot strips. Make a total of six yellow blocks.



3. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" green dot strip between two 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" green bubble floral strips lengthwise. Add 2" x 7-1/2" blue puppies strips.



Make a total of six green blocks.

4. Referring to the color quilt image, arrange panels and blocks in six rows of five. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete 35-1/2" x 42-1/2" unfinished quilt center.

5. Make two borders each with two 2" blue bubble floral strips stitched together end to end. Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim (borders approx. 42-1/2" unfinished). Sew remaining border strips to top and bottom of quilt center (borders approx. 38-1/2" unfinished).

6. Trim two 5-1/2" x 42" tossed animals strips equal to the width of the quilt center with first border, approximately 38-1/2" long. Stitch 5-1/2" square dog house square to each end of both trimmed borders. Set aside.

7. Stitch three 5-1/2" x 42" tossed animal strips together end to end. From this cut two borders equal to the length of the quilt center with first border, approximately 45-1/2" long. Stitch to right and left sides of quilt. Add top and bottom borders prepared in Step 6.

## Finishing:

1. Cut backing into two equal lengths. Sew the two lengths of backing together along selvage edges creating a two-panel wide backing. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from six 2-1/2" x 42" yellow dot strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
