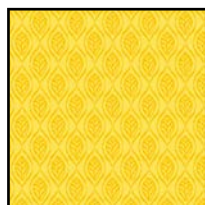

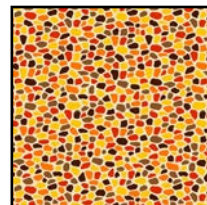

Cutting Instructions:

All measurements are based on a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Seams are pressed open.

Fabric 1, cut:

One 15" x 15" square, **Center Block.**

Fabric 2, cut:

Two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 15", **Border 1, Sides.**

Two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 1, Top & Bottom.**

Two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Border 3, Sides.**

Two $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 26", **Border 3, Top & Bottom.**

Fabric 3, cut:

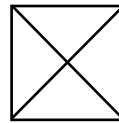
Twenty 2" x 7" rectangles, **Piece E.**

Four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF, **Binding.**

Fabric 4, cut:

Five $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", **Piece A.**

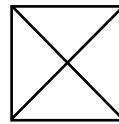
Cut in half diagonally twice.



Fabric 5, cut:

Five $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", **Piece B.**

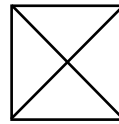
Cut in half diagonally twice.



Fabric 6, cut:

Five $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", **Piece C.**

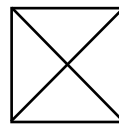
Cut in half diagonally twice.



Fabric 7, cut:

Five $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", **Piece D.**

Cut in half diagonally twice.



Fabric 8, cut:

Two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36", **Border 4, Top & Bottom Borders.**

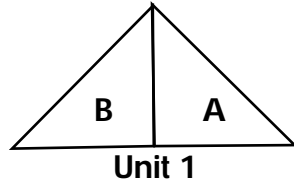
From remainder of fabric, cut lengthwise:

Two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26", **Border 4, Sides.**

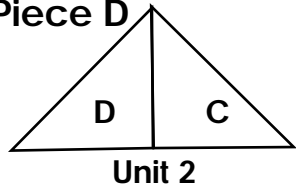
The fabric requirements are generous to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results. You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics. Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Block Directions:

Combine **Piece A** and **Piece B**
to make **Unit 1**.
Make 20 of **Unit 1**.



Combine **Piece C** and **Piece D**
to make **Unit 2**.
Make 20 of **Unit 2**.

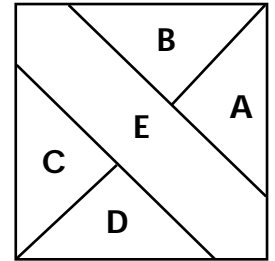


Combine **Piece E**
with **Unit 1** and **Unit 2**,
To make **Block 1**.

Note: Fold Piece E in half, press.
Then add Unit 1 with the seam lined up
with the fold crease of Piece E.
Repeat with Unit 2.

Square up each **Block 1**
to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Make 20 of **Block 1**.



Block 1

Quilt Assembly and Finishing:

1. Start with the **Center Block**.
Add **Border 1 Sides**, then **Border 1, Top & Bottom**.
2. Arrange the 20 **Block 1**'s so that they
match the picture of the quilt.
This will make **Border 2**.
3. Add **Border 3 Sides**,
then **Border 3, Top & Bottom**.
4. Add **Border 4 Sides**,
then **Border 4, Top & Bottom**.
5. Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
Baste and quilt.
6. Finish the quilt with the binding strips
and don't forget to put a label on your quilt.
